For many years, we have strived to build a caring school with God's love. We are proud to have very good teachers who walk with and take good care of our students. We also have a well-organized Counselling team providing all sorts of services which suit our students' needs. From time to time, parents share their feelings of appreciation with me - their thanks for how teachers provided timely, strong and suitable support for their sons and daughters.

As per tradition, I would like to talk about our students' DSE results this year. Students did perform well. The overall passing rate of all HKDSE subjects in our school is 98%. 12 subjects have a 100% passing rate. Our school offers a total of 17 HKDSE subjects with the overall level 4+ percentage well

above 50%. In particular, the level 4+ percentages of 6 subjects are higher than 70%. In terms of JUPAS offers, most of our students got a degree offer. CUHK, again, retains its title as the most popular university among our students, with 18 of this year's cohort having been accepted. And warm congratulations to them, I might add!
